## MINUTES OF THE LEE COUNTY FIRE ADVISORY BOARD

**May 12, 2011**

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The Lee County Fire Advisory Board met on May 12<sup>th</sup> at the Emergency Services Conference Room, located at 225 S Steele Street, Sanford, North Carolina.

Chairman Donald Andrews called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

A joint Q & A session between the Fire Advisory Board and representatives of each of the county's seven volunteer fire departments was conducted to obtain answers to questions concerning their FY2011/12 budget requests.

Budget information received from the fire department representatives was discussed in great detail before approval and recommendation could be granted from the Fire Advisory Board. Chairman Andrews will recommend the FY11/12 fire department budget requests to the Board of Commissioners during the 3 p.m. budget review session scheduled for Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2011.

Larry Kelly made a motion, seconded by Linda Shook, to accept and recommend Northwest Pocket's budget request of \$191,751, resulting in a projected rate of \$0.124/\$100; unanimous vote.

Linda Shook made a motion, seconded by Larry Kelly, to keep Tramway's budget flat and recommend a budget of \$326,938, resulting in a projected rate of \$0.078/\$100; unanimous vote.

Royce Gaines made a motion, seconded by Linda Shook, to accept and recommend Lemon Springs' budget request of \$274,500, resulting in a projected rate of \$0.086/\$100; unanimous vote.

Larry Kelly made a motion, seconded by Donald Andrews, to accept and recommend Northview's budget request of \$486,606, resulting in a projected rate of \$0.081/\$100; unanimous vote.

Royce Gaines made a motion, seconded by Larry Kelly, to accept and recommend Cape Fear's budget request of \$255,650, resulting in a projected rate of \$0.087/\$100; unanimous vote.


Linda Shook made a motion, seconded by Royce Gaines, to accept and recommend Deep River's budget request of \$219,130, resulting in a projected rate of \$0.104/\$100; unanimous vote.

Larry Kelly made a motion, seconded by Royce Gaines, to accept and recommend Carolina Trace's budget request of \$233,190, resulting in a projected rate of \$0.067/\$100; unanimous vote.
