The Lee County Local Emergency Planning Committee met on March 19, 2014 at Lee County Emergency Services, 204 West Courtland Drive, Sanford, NC.

Chairman Roger Tankersley called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.; meeting attendees introduced themselves.

A motion was made by Shane Seagroves to accept the meeting minutes, as presented, from the December 18, 2013 meeting; seconded by Gaynell Lee; unanimous vote.

Chairman Tankersley encouraged attendees to submit any emergency contact, equipment or expertise updates to Roger or Nancy.




