The Lee County Local Emergency Planning Committee met on September 26, 2012 at the McSwain Extension Education and Agriculture Center, 2420 Tramway Road, Sanford, NC.

Chairperson Roger Tankersley called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. A motion was made by Phil Misklow to accept the meeting minutes as presented from the June 20, 2012 meeting; seconded by David Vann; unanimous vote.

Old Business:

Shane commented on the action item from 6/20/2012 stating that the Extension Disaster Education Network (EDEN) subcommittee has not met yet due to time limitations. Moving forward, objectives are to call a meeting of the subcommittee in the November timeframe; schedule EDEN training throughout the community by the onset of next year.

New Business:

Heath Cain gave a report on the Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) Plan. He stated the next scoring date for the SNS Annual Review would occur during the week of March 4, 2013; the minimum score of the review was changed to 79. Disks are available with the new plan, which he plans to distribute to the LEPC at the December meeting. Heath also mentioned the first Closed Pod Exercise which was held at Southern Lee High School Media Center on August 24, 2012. During the exercise, Tdap vaccinations were provided to all faculty and administration associated with the public school system; a total of 208 individuals were vaccinated.

Brandon Poythress, from Recovery Logistics, LLC gave the presentation, "Disaster Recovery Business Continuity Capabilities". Recovery Logistics specializes in business continuity and disaster recovery operations helping businesses recover from hurricanes, winter floods, and other unplanned events. Their capabilities include fuel resources, transportation logistics, power restoration, base camp logistics, mobile medical units, critical supplies, water purification, and generators.

Shane gave details of the "Family Day @ the Jetport", which will be held October 6, 9am – 5pm. This year, in addition to the usual aircraft displays and demonstrations, will be a two-hour aerobatic air show. Anyone wishing to volunteer for this event should contact Nancy.

Shane also mentioned the equipment failure incident that occurred at Noble Oil earlier this year and commended the Public-Private Partnerships between government agencies and the private sector during the response. Yoke Chung stated that the incident is still being evaluated.

Shane reminded everyone to begin preparing now for what could be a harsh winter. Pre-planning includes checking weather radios, emergency plans, and updating contact lists, etc.

Steve Powers mentioned that the FEMA grant has been approved for the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan, which will allow the counties of Lee, Chatham, Moore and Harnett to develop one regional plan. He also made mention that the 2012 Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG) was available and to contact Shane if anyone needs them.

Action Items:

- Shane Seagroves will give an update of the EDEN Sub-committee plan of action for scheduling meetings and offerings of training at the December LEPC meeting.
- Roger Millikin will update the Emergency Contact List

The next meeting for the LEPC has been pre-scheduled for December 19, 2012. David Vann has agreed to host or sponsor the meeting.

Therefore, being no further business to come before the LEPC, the meeting was adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
