The Lee County Local Emergency Planning Committee met on June 20, 2012 at the McSwain Extension Education and Agriculture Center, 2420 Tramway Road, Sanford, NC.

Chairperson Roger Tankersley called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. A motion was made by Shane Seagroves to accept the meeting minutes as presented from the March 21, 2012 meeting; seconded by Kimberly Killian; unanimous vote.

Old Business:

Roy Warren informed the group that the Strategic National Stockpile Plan received a score of 97.7% out of a maximum score of 100 during the recent assessment by the State. Heath Cain was commended for his time and efforts spent on updating the plan.

Mr. Warren provided an update on the SNS Closed Points of Dispensing (POD) Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) stating that the MOA has now been approved by the Board of Health for the County of Lee.

Roger Tankersley commented on the follow-up of action item from 3/21/2012. Mike Perry is willing to present findings on Tyson Foods Risk Management Plan (RMP) at a future LEPC meeting.

New Business:

Roger Tankersley read a letter of resignation from Hans Niedworok, who has resigned due to health issues.

Heath Cain provided a draft document of the MOA regarding Mass Prophylaxis Dispensing Closed Points of Dispensing to the committee members for review.

Dr. Mike Yoder and Natalie Hampton gave a presentation on "Extension Disaster Education Network (EDEN) Resources. EDEN links Cooperative Extension Service educators from across the U.S., enabling them to use and share educational resources to reduce the impact of disasters. EDEN also provides access to valuable online resources and disaster organizations via their website www.EDEN.lsu.edu.

After the presentation, there was some discussion about "Ready Business" a program developed by EDEN designed to help businesses create their continuity and disaster preparedness plans. It was noted that an estimated 25% of businesses do not reopen following a major disaster. From this discussion, a sub-group of the LEPC was created to look at logistics of sponsoring EDEN training throughout the community. The sub-group consists of the following members: Shane Seagroves (Chair), Roger Tankersley, Kimberly Killian, Susan Condlin, and Michele Bullard.

Action Item:

- Shane Seagroves will call a meeting of the sub-group to discuss plans of community awareness for EDEN.

The next meeting for the LEPC has been pre-scheduled for September 19, 2012.

Therefore, being no further business to come before the LEPC, the meeting was adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
