*Old Business:*

Shane presented data on the five Risk Management Plan (RMP) facilities in Lee County. RMPs are required to be submitted to the EPA by facilities possessing greater than certain threshold quantities of high-risk chemicals.

*New Business:*

Colin Falato, Branch Manager for HEPACO, presented "The Public and Private Partnership in a Hazmat Response". HEPACO is an emergency response and environmental remediation company, which also provides homeland security and industrial services.

Updates of SNS Plan per Heath Cain's email:

- SNS Plan is being graded by the State March 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> in Raleigh.
- Lee County Health Department is planning to present the proposed SNS closed Points of Dispensing (POD) Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to the Board of Health for approval at their next meeting.

Chairman Roger Tankersley asked the committee to think about what other topics they would like to see covered in future presentations.

Action Item:

- Chairman Tankersley will contact Mike Perry of Tyson Foods to find out what had been done in the past relative to sharing information with the community on Tyson's RMP.
